Opening doors for people in our communities.

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In 2024, HSMM **provided case management for 1111 adults and 672 children**. Total Financial Support = \$2,749,590.

Eaton County:

~**Emergency Rental Assistance:** 341 households (392 adults, 285 children). Included in this number were 143 homeless, 102 evictions, 96 relocations, and 39 foreclosures. Direct financial assistance totaled \$304,830.

~**Extended Services:** Provided housing stability for 12 households (13 adults & 12 children), totaling \$5,288.

Clinton County:

~**Emergency Rental Assistance:** 136 households with 143 adults and 89 children. Included in this number were 44 homeless, 55 evictions, and 37 relocations. Direct financial assistance totaled \$125,830.

~**Emergency Shelter Program:** Provided 485 nights of shelter for 33 households (44 adults, 34 children). Funding = \$40,809.

Eaton & Clinton Counties:

~**Mainstream Voucher Program:** Rental subsidies of \$1,713,287 for 232 disabled voucher holders (267 adults & 101 children).

~**Permanent Supportive Housing:** 44 units for chronically homeless singles/families where an adult has a disability. This includes 58 adults and 25 children. Rental subsidy for these households totaled \$368,829.

~**Rapid Re-Housing:** Rental subsidies of \$190,717 for 23 displaced families (35 adults & 50 children).

~**Shared Housing Intervention Program:** 36 couch-homeless families with school-aged children were enrolled in SHIP case management. This included 51 adults and 76 children.

Tri-County Outreach: (Clinton, Eaton & Ingham)

~**PATH/SOAR Street Outreach:** 453 individuals contacted/located and 63 enrolled in PATH/SOAR case management.

~**Mortgage Foreclosures:** 91 households contacted HSMM and 39 were enrolled for case management.

~**Property Tax Foreclosures:** 11 households contacted HSMM and 4 were enrolled for case management.

~**Home Buyer Education:** 7 households contacted HSMM and 2 were assisted with Home Buyer Education on-line classes.

In 2023, HSMM **provided case management for 1123 adults and 861 children**. Total Financial Support = \$2,481,792.

CERA assistance ended in 2022. No CERA funding was available in 2023.

Eaton County:

~**Emergency Rental Assistance:** 398 households (467 adults, 395 children). Included in this number were 116 homeless, 191 evictions, 90 relocations, and 1 foreclosure. Direct financial assistance totaled \$374,025.

~**Extended Services:** Provided housing stability for 16 households (20 adults & 30 children), totaling \$20,696.

Clinton County:

~**Emergency Rental Assistance:** 127 households with 150 adults and 114 children. Included in this number were 40 homeless, 61 evictions, and 26 relocations. Direct financial assistance totaled \$125,184.

~**Emergency Shelter Program:** Provided 748 nights of shelter for 47 households (71 adults, 84 children). Funding = \$59,829.

Eaton & Clinton Counties:

~**Mainstream Voucher Program:** Rental subsidies of \$1,452,470 for 217 disabled voucher holders (252 adults & 102 children).

~**Permanent Supportive Housing:** 40 units for chronically homeless singles/families where an adult has a disability. This includes 52 adults and 25 children. Rental subsidy for these households totaled \$330,608.

~**Rapid Re-Housing:** Rental subsidies of \$94,394 for 18 displaced families (27 adults & 38 children).

~**Shared Housing Intervention Program:** 34 couch-homeless families with school-aged children were enrolled in SHIP case management and received \$5,716 in assistance. This included 41 adults and 73 children.

Tri-County Outreach: (Clinton, Eaton & Ingham)

~**PATH/SOAR Street Outreach:** 309 individuals contacted/located and 37 enrolled in PATH/SOAR case management.

~**Home Buyer Education:** 6 households were assisted with Home Buyer Education on-line classes.
